Ó Máille, an award-winning teacher, has experience instructing all levels of language training. He is a member of various Irish language organizations, including *Daltaí na Gaeilge* and *Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Éireann*.

All are welcome to attend—beginners to fluent speakers, students and adults. We invite you to join us for this inaugural course to learn to speak and understand the language that is an integral part of Irish culture and heritage. There's sure to be a bit of *craic* (fun) along the way! *Bígí linn*!
